

ORDINANCE NO. 81

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE PER DIEM COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHOUDRANT FOR ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS OF THE BOARD; AND OTHERWISE TO PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Choudrant, Louisiana, convened in Regular Session this 12th day of September, 2005, that the following Ordinance is hereby enacted:

SECTION 1.

Each member of the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Choudrant shall receive for attendance at meetings of the Board a per diem of TWENTY-FIVE AND NO/THS (\$25.00) DOLLARS, per meeting. No more than one per diem shall be paid for more than one board meeting occurring on any calendar day.

SECTION 2.

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause and/or phrase of this Ordinance or the application thereof is declared unconstitutional, unenforceable or invalid by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction such unconstitutionality, unenforceability or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and/or phrases of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Village of Choudrant, Louisiana without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional, unenforceable or invalid section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase. To this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 3.

All other ordinances, or any parts thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall become effective upon approval of the Mayor.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was introduced by Eddie Ford at the regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Choudrant, Louisiana, held on August 1, 2005 who thereafter moved for its adoption. The motion was seconded by Jimmy McGrew and after having been considered by title was adopted as a whole by the following YEA and NAY vote:
